



GOLF LEAGUE CONTRACT FOR THE 2011 SEASON

This agreement, between _____ Glacier Club _____, referred to in this agreement as "CLUB", and _____ Golf League, referred to in this Agreement as "LEAGUE", granting the LEAGUE the privilege of using The Glaciers and facilities according to the following terms and provisions on the guidelines page.

FEES AND PAYMENT

**Payments must be made in one lump sum payment.
1/2 of all league fees are due prior to the first week,
and 1/2 are due prior to the middle of the season.**

League Guidelines

LICENSE FOR USE OF GOLF COURSE AND FACILITIES

The LEAGUE shall have a revocable license to use the golf course and facilities of CLUB, during the term of this contract. The CLUB reserves the right to revoke the license of any LEAGUE whose teams or players, individually or collectively, violate provisions of this Contract, or the golf course rules and regulations adopted by the CLUB and/or otherwise posted at the CLUB facilities. LEAGUE play and players shall be governed by the terms of this contract and the rules, regulations and policies of The Glaciers. Revocation of this license shall result in forfeiture of all playing privileges and LEAGUE deposit.

SOFT SPIKES

Non-metal spikes will be required for the 2011 season and all seasons thereafter.

COMMENCEMENT OF PLAY

LEAGUES must play a minimum of sixteen (16) weeks.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

If the LEAGUE cannot begin play within 15 minutes of scheduled time because of rain, snow, lightning or other adverse conditions, play must be cancelled and rescheduled. If the last foursome in the LEAGUE has finished the 5th hole, the night is assumed to be a completed league night. If the last foursome has not completed the 5th hole, play will be rescheduled. The rescheduled week will be added on to the end of the scheduled play. **LEAGUE players should report to the golf course as scheduled, regardless of weather conditions, to await the golf courses determination of whether play will commence or be rescheduled.**

SLOW PLAY

The LEAGUE and all of its players commit themselves to play at a reasonable pace. Consideration will be given based on the pace of the group ahead of you but reasonable will be defined as follows: Two hours fifteen minutes to two and one half hours for nine holes. The first foursome on a given nine taking longer than two and one half hours will be deemed in violation of the slow play policy. A team who violates this slow play policy will receive one warning. A second violation by the same team will cause that team to lose their playing privileges for the next week and forfeit their fees for that week. The LEAGUE officer shall be notified of the first and second violations and maintain a record of violations. A third violation by the same team will result in license revocation for the entire LEAGUE, forfeiture of playing privileges for all LEAGUE members and forfeiture of LEAGUE deposit.

DRESS CODE

Dress must meet the requirements of the golfer's policies and procedures.

1. Men – collared shirts are required (mocks are acceptable)
2. No short shorts or cut offs are allowed.

Dress code is subject to courses discretion.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

Alcoholic beverages may only be purchased in the clubhouse or on the grounds. If a player is drinking alcoholic beverages on the golf course or grounds of the CLUB, not purchased here, including the parking lot, he/she and his/her team shall be removed from the premises immediately. The golf privileges of the offending player and team shall be suspended for the following two weeks and result in a forfeiture of the fees for those suspended weeks. An offense by a single player shall be considered an offense by the entire team of which he/she is a member. The LEAGUE officer shall be notified of the suspension and maintain a record of violations. A second violation by any player from the same team will result in license revocation of the entire LEAGUE, forfeiture of playing privileges for all LEAGUE members and forfeiture of LEAGUE deposit.

1. Coolers or any type of beverage containers not purchased from the CLUB containing alcoholic beverages are prohibited from being brought onto the CLUB premises and subjects the offender to the same violation policy stated above, regardless of whether the player or team was actually drinking alcoholic beverages.
2. Regulations pertaining to alcoholic beverages will be strictly and vigorously enforced as required by the Michigan Liquor Control Commission.

GOLF COURSE RULES AND REGULATIONS

Golf Course Rules and Regulations adopted by the CLUB, at any time shall be binding on the LEAGUE and its players. The Golf Course rules and regulations shall be provided to the LEAGUE or shall be posted on the premises, but in either event, shall be deemed sufficient notice to the LEAGUE. In the absence of local rules, the rules of the United States Golf Association shall govern play and customary golf course etiquette shall be required to assure that the sport of golf shall remain a pleasant and enjoyable experience for the LEAGUE and the CLUB.

Local Rule: All out of bounds will be played as a lateral water hazard.
All carts should be at least 30 yards from tees and greens.
All players should fix their own ball marks, and replace their own divots.

RENEWAL

It is furthermore agreed that this contract does not imply that a contract will be available or offered for any other season other than that decied herein, and that requests for renewal shall be made by the league no sooner than Sept. 1st 2012 or later than Oct. 1, 2012. The LEAGUE will not be recognized or having playing privileges unless a new signed contract is on file with the CLUB.

AMENDMENTS

It is agreed that any amendments, revisions of alterations to this Contract shall be in writing. Oral statements shall not have any binding effect. The only contract between the parties is this agreement. Any prior written contracts or agreements between the parties are revoked.
